IMPORTANT:

- 1. It is a criminal offence to fail to notify the MO of any disclosable pecuniary interests (DPI), or to knowingly provide information that is false or misleading (or being reckless as to whether the information is true and not misleading).
- 2. This form must be returned within 28 days of your election or appointment to office. You must register your DPI in the Council's register maintained under Sections 30(3) and 235(2) of the Localism Act 2011 and provide written notification of details to the Clerk to the Council and the MO.
- 3. Where the DPI is not entered in the Council's register and is not the subject of a pending notification, but is disclosed at a meeting of the Council (or any committee, sub-committee, joint committee, or joint sub-committee), you must within 28 days beginning with the date of the disclosure provide written notification to the Clerk to the Council and to the MO.
- 4. Where the DPI is not entered in the Council's register and is not the subject of a pending notification, you must within 28 clays beginning with the date you become aware that you have a DPI in any matter to be clealt with, or being dealt with, by you acting alone whilst discharging a function of the Council provide written notification to the Clerk to the Council and to the MO.

- 5. [The Code of Conduct (the Code) for Members requires you to notify the MO of any DPIs before the end of 28 days beginning with the day on which the Code takes effect. Failure to comply with this requirement would not of itself be a criminal offence but could lead to action being taken against you under the Code.]
